

Outstanding Teacher Programme

Who is this programme for?

The Outstanding Teacher Programme is open to teachers with the potential and capacity to deliver consistently outstanding lessons and who will take key ideas and skills back to their school to share, or even lead, on some teaching and learning initiatives within their department/faculty or across the school.

The OTP consists of 5 teaching & learning sessions and 2 coaching sessions with a series of post session challenges, completed over a term. This is interspersed with three in school practice sessions where participants have the opportunity to apply the skills acquired to classroom practice, reflect and feedback to the group.

Programme Objectives

To provide teachers with:

- the ability to demonstrate higher level understanding of teaching and improve learning for their pupils
- the ability to coach colleagues and pupils in their own school and in other schools to raise performance levels
- the ability to create a proactive school culture where the quality of teaching and learning is openly observed, discussed, challenged and enhanced
- increased professional satisfaction and create opportunities for further leadership and career progression
